About the Oceania Apostolic Congress on Mercy

The first OACOM was held in Samoa in 2009 as a direct result of the first World Apostolic Congress On Mercy (WACOM) held in Rome 2008. At this event's conclusion all participating country members were required to organise Continental Congresses for each region. The objective being to 'continue to light the fire of mercy in the four corners of the earth and pass on the message of hope for mankind and peace for the world through the Divine Mercy of God.' This was truly continued again in Samoa for the second time at OACOM 2013. New Zealand held the next OACOM in 2016 with great success.

Now we are proud to be inviting people to Australia for the first time from the Oceania Region to attend the 4th OACOM in 2018 to "continue to light the fire of mercy on earth".

Guest Speakers



Cardinal Soane Patita Paini Mafi of Tonga. He was appointed Bishop of Tonga in 2007. On 14 February 2015, Pope Francis appointed Mafi a cardinal with the title of Cardinal-Priest of Santa Paola Romana.



Archbishop Alapati Lui Mataeliga of Samoa. (Continental Coordinator Divine Mercy Oceania Region) He was appointed by the Holy See as the second Archbishop of Samoa-Apia on November 16, 2002 and was consecrated as the Apostolic Nuncio to Samoa, on January 3, 2003.



Archbishop Gintaras Linas Grusas of Vilnius, Lithuania. He was appointed Archbishop of Vilnius in April 2013 and is the Apostolic Administrator for the Military Ordinariate of Lithuania.



Archbishop Julian Porteous of Tasmania is the Spiritual Director for Divine Mercy in Australia. He was appointed Archbishop of Hobart on 17 September 2013.



Father Rory Morrissey from New Zealand. He is the Spiritual Director of Divine Mercy in New Zealand and has been promoting the Divine Mercy for over 25 years.



Father Gabriel Cillo is a recently ordained Marian Priest. He will give his powerful witness of forgiveness and devotion to the Divine Mercy.



Father Dariux Drewiecki, a Marian Priest based at the Divine Mercy Shrine in the Phillipines, has been appointed a Missionary of Mercy priest. He will describe the power of a Good Confession.



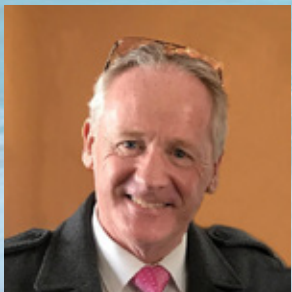
Lesina Levy is the Divine Mercy Secretary General for the Oceania Region. Her presentation will be about how, "Now is the Time for Mercy".
